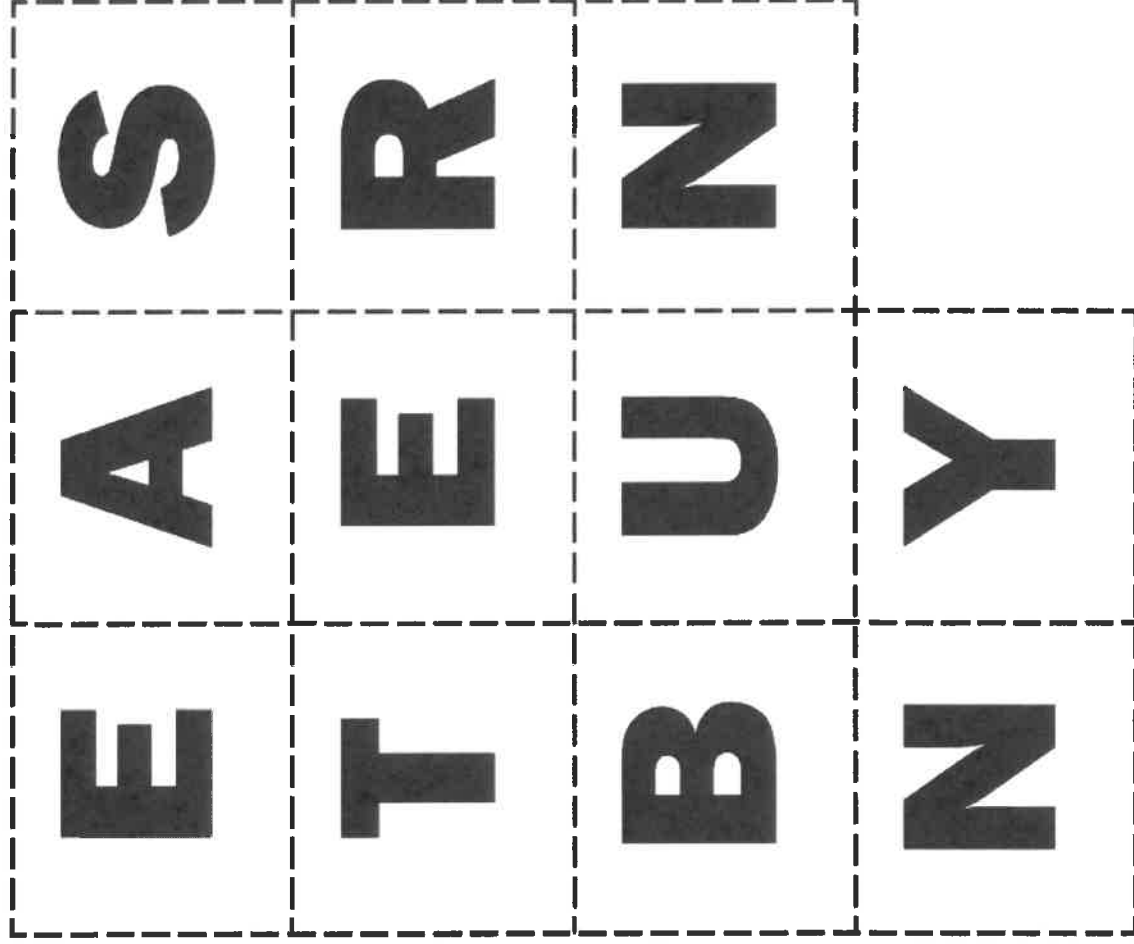
## Letter Mix-Up

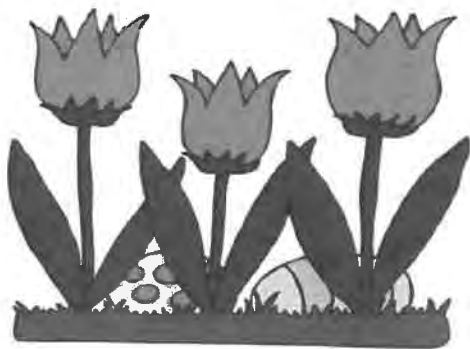

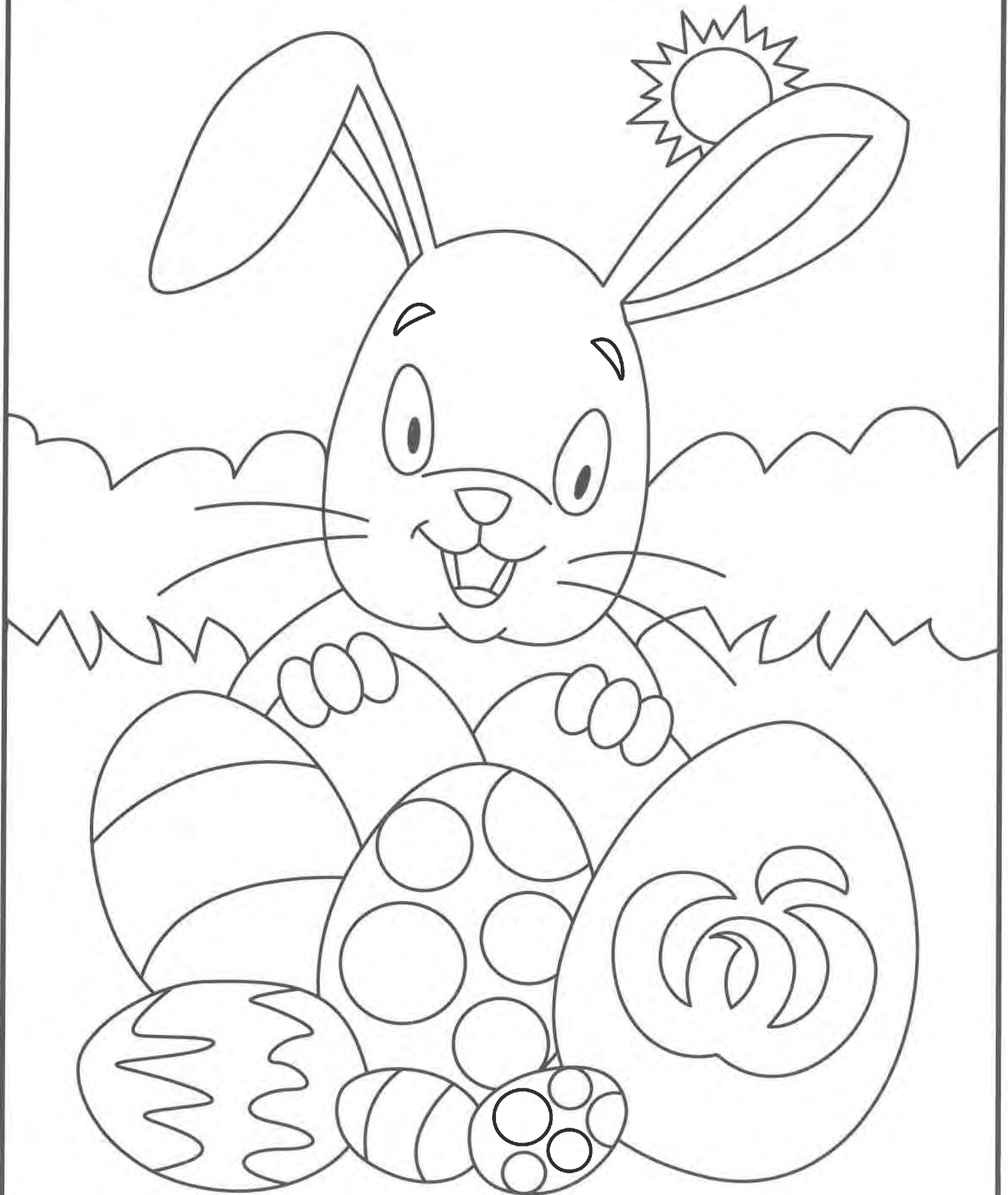
- Check to be sure all words are spelled correctly.

### Step 3: Adjust the font and size.

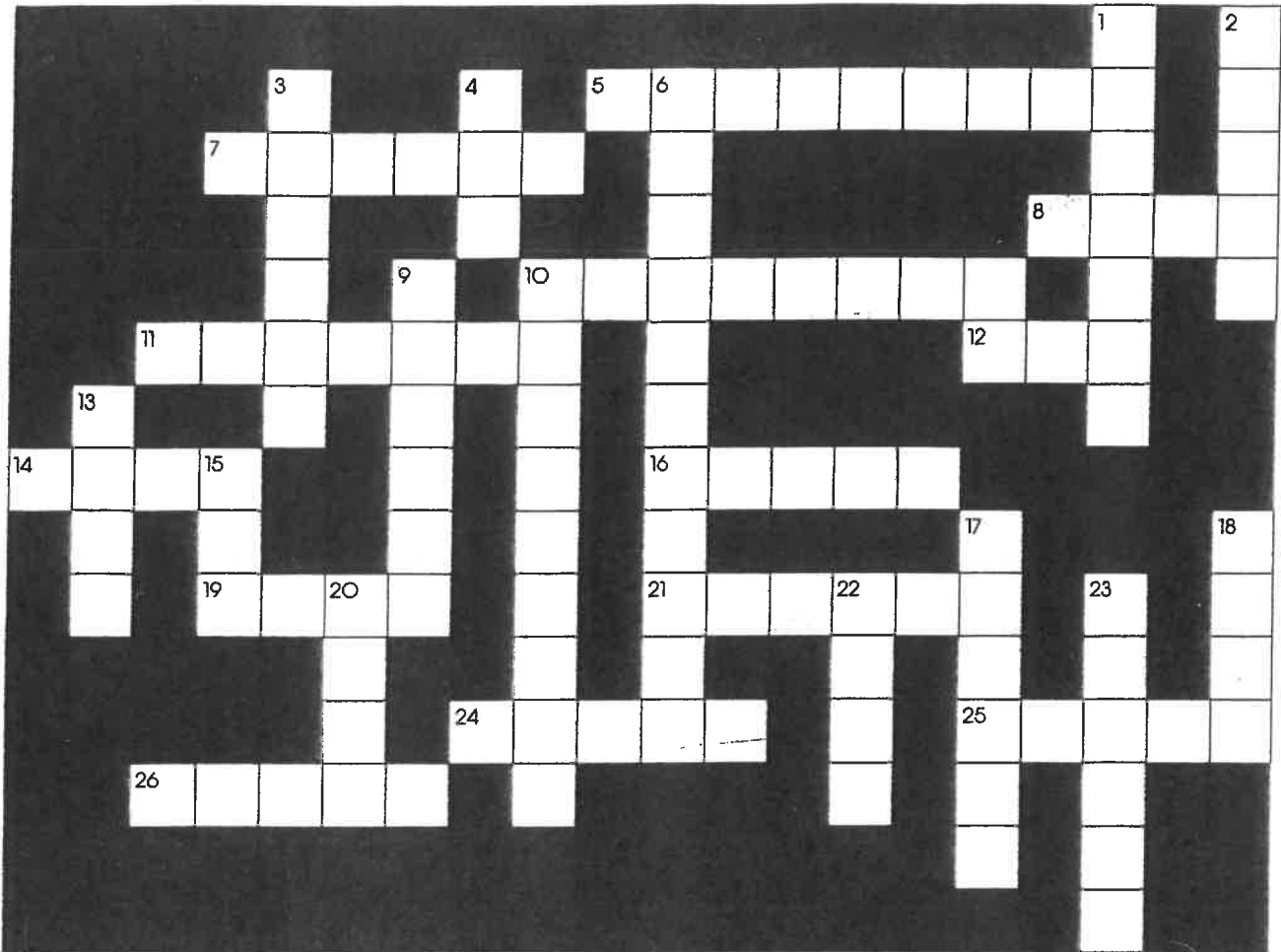
- Choose a basic font that is easy to read, such as Arial or Verdana.
