Dear Parents and Caregivers

As a Catholic Pastoral Community, we commit to forming and maintaining Christ-like relationships through the steps we take to provide for the pastoral needs of our students, staff and families. One way we can assist the families in our school is through the provision of meals.

To continue to provide this support, we require the assistance of our school community. All that is necessary, is for you to make a meal adequate enough for at least four people. It is only restricted to your imagination as to what you make (and what can be frozen), but some meals that have been appreciated in the past are soups, stews, curries, spaghetti bolognaise, lasagne and pies.

Please place the food in a container that can be frozen, clearly marking the date the meal was cooked and what it is; for example, CHICKEN CURRY 20/06/2022. Please also list the ingredients used in the meal so that we can cater for food allergies. The school can assist in providing take away containers if you need them.

We request that your meals be brought to the front office where they can be transferred to the freezer until needed by families in need. This need may be due to a new baby, a sick family member, a death in the family or a family going through a difficult time for whatever reason.

This is a great opportunity for those who wish to help our school community but are unable to do so during school hours due to work commitments.
