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Art Competition Terms and Conditions

Eligibility:

- a. The art competition is open to all artists from participating schools.
- b. Employees, directors and officers of Roy Hill Community Foundation members, their employees and immediate family members are not eligible to participate.

Entry Submission:

- a. Participants may submit their entries by delivery to an address nominated in the Art Registration Form.
- b. Each school may submit three entries.
- c. All entries must be received by 4pm Wednesday 28 June 2023.
- d. Entries must comply with the following:
 - i. The artwork must be an original creation by the participant(s).
 - ii. The artwork must not infringe any third-party rights including copyright, trademarks or intellectual property.
 - iii. The artwork must not contain any offensive, defamatory, or inappropriate content.

Copyright and Intellectual Property:

- a. Participants retain the copyright and intellectual property rights of their submitted artworks.
- b. By entering the competition, participants grant the Roy Hill Community Foundation a non-exclusive licence to reproduce, display and promote the submitted artwork for the purposes of the competition including but not limited to promotional materials, website display and social media promotion.
- c. The above licence granted to the Roy Hill Community Foundation is limited to the duration of the competition and any associated promotional activities.

Judging and Selection:

- a. The judging will consist of Roy Hill Community Foundation member employees.
- b. The judging panel's decision is final and binding in all matters related to the competition.
- c. Participants will be notified of the competition results on Friday 7 July 2.



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Prizes:

- a. The prizes for the competition will be exhibition opportunities, merchandise and prizes donated by Roy Hill Community Foundation member companies.
- b. The prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or any other alternatives.

Use of Entries:

- a. By participating in the competition, participants grant Hancock Prospecting the right to use their name, likeness and submitted artwork for promotional and marketing purposes related to the competition without any additional compensation.

Liability and Indemnification:

- a. The Roy Hill Community Foundation and its affiliates, officers, directors, employees and agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury incurred by participants during the competition.
- b. Participants shall indemnify and hold the Roy Hill Community Foundation harmless from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from their participation in the competition or any breach of these terms and conditions.

Modification and Termination:

- a. The Roy Hill Community Foundation reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the competition at any time without prior notice.
- b. In the event of termination, the Roy Hill Community Foundation shall not be held liable to participants.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

Any dispute arising in relation to these terms and conditions must be determined as follows:

- a. The parties must meet and confidentially and in good faith to attempt to resolve the dispute. If the dispute is not resolved within 20 Business Days of the last date for the meeting of delegates under this clause, the matter will be and is hereby referred to arbitration.
- b. The seat of the arbitration will be Perth, Western Australia and the arbitration is to take place in Perth before a single arbitrator. The arbitrator will be nominated by ACICA, upon the application of either party.
