Your child has the opportunity to attend the Year Five/Six Camp to be held from 17 to 21 July 2023 (Week One, Term Three).



Departure Time:

8:00am Monday the 17 July - students to arrive at school by 7:30am to allow

time to load the bus.

Estimated Time of return: 4pm Friday the 21 July (A text will be sent to confirm a more accurate time,

please ensure your mobile contact is up to date with the school office.)

Transport:

The school has hired a bus.

There is to be no eating on the bus. We will stop at Pardoo and Sandfire for breaks. At these times the students will need to ensure they eat and use the

toilet facilities.

Packed lunch:

Students are required to bring a packed Recess and Lunch for the trip to Broome on Monday. There will be the opportunity to purchase food and/or drinks at Pardoo Roadhouse, but we do suggest packing a lunch box for your

child to snack on throughout the day and during our travel breaks.

Accident or illness:

In the case of an accident or illness treatment will be performed at the place it occurs and if required further medical attention at the local Doctors or Hospital will be carried out. Parents will be informed as soon as possible. Any costs incurred as a result of accident or illness will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian. All medications will need to be given to class teachers on the Monday morning of departure (labelled in a zip lock bag). Staff will secure these in a locked box and administer when required/needed. Parents are responsible

for any medical costs incurred in case of accident or illness


Spending Money:






